The **House of Welcome** helps refugees and asylum seekers settle into Australia.

The **House of Welcome** is a project of the NSW Ecumerical Council.

We help people who:

- are on Temporary Protection Visas
- are Asylum Seekers on Bridging Visa E's within a legal process
- are on Habeas Corpus Court Orders

WHAT CAN WE DO?

The first time you come to the **House of Welcome**, we will interview you to find out what you need.

WE CAN HELP

with these things:

- We can offer you short term accommodation.
- We can help you get Medicare, Centrelink and Travel concession cards.
- We can help you find a house to live in.
- We have free English Classes.
- We have free Computer Classes.
- We can help you look for work if you are allowed to work.
- We can arrange a short free holiday for you and your family.
- We can help you make appointments with the Service for Treatment and Rehabilitation of Torture and Trauma Survivors (STARTTS) and the Refugee Advisory and Casework Service (RACS)
- We can help you make appointments with doctors and other people.
